THE PROSIGN INT IS PROVIDED FOR THAT TURPOSE AND ALL REQUESTS FOR REPEATS OF A GROUP/S OR AN ENTIRE TRANSMISSION SHOULD BE PRECEDED BY INT. FOR EXAMPLE: INT OR K; INT AS PLACE; KIMT AA PLACE; HAVING MISSED THE ENTIRE TRANSMISSION, SIMPLY INT.

HEADLINE WRITERS WENT TO TOWN ON THE "LONELY JOBS FOR SECOND HONEYMDONERS" AND JUST ABOUT EVERY PAPER IN THE COUNTRY RAN THE STORY. NEXT DAY THE ASSOCIATED PRESS AND THE INTERNATIONAL NEWS SERVICE PICKED IT UP AND EMBROIDERED IT A BIT. RADIO NEWSCASTERS MEN-TICHED IT, AND HAMEDIATELY THE STATIONS' TELE-PHONES HERE CLOSSED WITH CALLS FOR MORE IMPOR-MAT 10N.

NIXT DAY, 900 TELEGRAMS CAME IN ASKING FOR MORE INFORMATION AT ONCE. THAT MIGHT MR. PLETT TOOK OFF FOR SEATTLE, AND BY THE TIME HE GOT THORE, TWO MAILBAGS FU'L OF LETTERS WERE WATT-INC FOR HIM, ASKING ABOUT THIS WONDERFUL JOB. MEANWHILE, IN WASHINGTON AND SEATTLE, LETTERS POURED IN, AND THE CAA PERSONNEL SERVICE FULLED OUT THE LAST OF JTS HAIR, QUIT SCREAM-IMA AND FELL INTO THE PILES OF LETTERS ON THE IN WASHINGTON, 10,000 LETTERS WERE RECEIVED, IN SEATTLE, 6,000.
