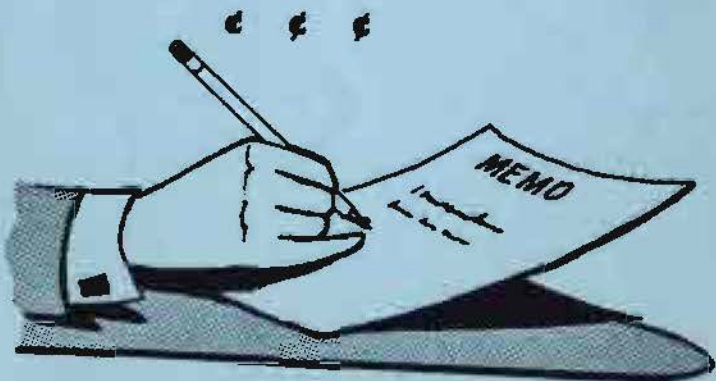

TELEPHONE SYSTEM AND USE

Telephone System

The telephone system follows a new and modern concept of direct communications; basically, that of answering your own telephone. In conjunction with this approach, individuals, with the exception of clerical staff, have been given an identity by the assignment of a separate number.

Where required, certain employees will have one number to receive calls and a separate number to originate calls. The second number should not be generally disclosed. However, the second can be used for emergency access, similar to intercom capability, to superiors or subordinates. It is recommended that this arrangement be restricted as much as possible. Use only your second number to originate calls.

Telephone Conference Arrangements

To preclude the need for multiple intercoms and complex extension arrangements, the following capabilities are available.

Manual Conference. For a conference requirement of not more than five participants, call the FAA operator and give the names and/or extensions necessary. The operator will make the necessary connections manually on the switchboard.

Automatic Conference. For a conference requirement of not more than ten participants, inform each party to dial "80" at a predetermined time. Following the above procedure will place all required participants on an automatic telephone conference. This capability will be available at all times and does not require the presence of an operator.

Long Distance Conference. When a conference connection is required on receipt of a long distance call, place the call on hold and call the operator and give the names and/or extensions required. The operator will notify the requested participants and arrange the conference.

Modifications of Telephone System

To obtain modifications of telephone systems, i.e., additional equipment required, change of location of ring, etc., forward a memorandum to the Administrative Property Section, AL-41.2, for review and clearance.

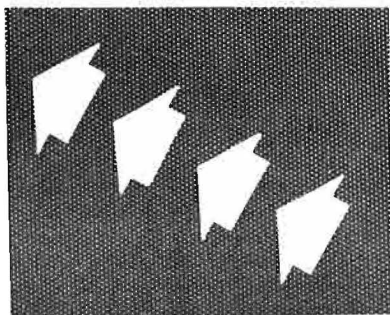
